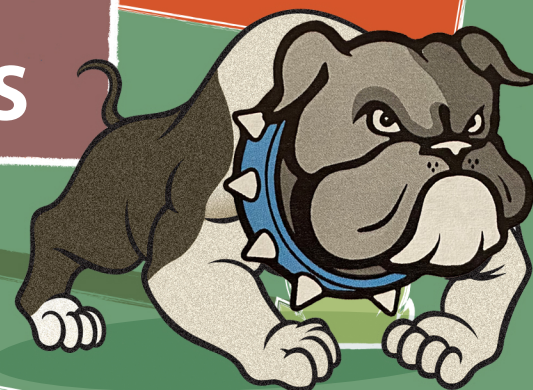
OUR MISSION

FOUNDATION HIGHLIGHTS

- The FOEF Golf Tournament and Red Barn Bash raised \$34,986

- Awarded approximately \$17,000 in dual credit and AP college scholarships helping offset enrollment fees for over 250 students
